

Why bring Ziply Fiber internet to your neighborhood?

Our fast, reliable internet can be a game-changer in more than one way.

Fiber gives you fast internet speeds all the time. With traditional cable, your network connection can slow down at peak times of day when everyone gets online. On our fiber network, you don't share your connection with your neighbors, so your speeds stay consistently fast. 24/7.

Our network is built to handle today's demands. Think of our network like a highway—the less traffic, the faster you go. We leave lots of room on our network by operating at 40% capacity, so you won't experience slowdowns, lag or buffering wheels.

Fiber may increase property values. A study done by the University of Colorado and Carnegie Mellon University showed fiber availability can increase home values by up to 3.1%. That's an increase of more than \$17,050 for the sample median home price of \$550,000.

Our plans have no strings attached. Ziply Fiber internet plans come with no data caps, no annual contracts, no credit checks and a 30-day moneyback guarantee. If for some reason you're not thrilled with our service, you can switch anytime.







How Neighborly Partnerships works

Here's how to start the process of bringing fiber to your community. We're even offering 0% interest, 24-month financing to help lower the cost.

- 1. **Determine neighborhood interest.** Talk to your neighbors about pooling resources to bring fiber internet to your neighborhood. The more people who come together, the lower the cost per individual.
- 2. Let us know you're interested. Complete the form on the web page listed below.
- **3.** We'll assess feasibility. If your neighborhood is close to our fiber network, our technical experts will determine the most cost-effective way to deliver service. (Note: for various reasons, not all communities will be eligible for fiber.)
- **4. We'll deliver a proposal.** If the plan is feasible, we'll get back to you with the approximate costs and project timeline.
- **5. Sign build agreements.** Once you're ready to move forward, we'll present the necessary legal forms for you and your neighbors to sign.
- 6. We'll start the work. Once work is scheduled, we'll keep you posted as we get closer to

What goes into bringing fiber to your neighborhood?

Before starting construction, survey crews will come out to your neighborhood to do inspections and field surveys. From there, we'll get to work either hanging fiber lines from utility poles or burying them underground. Once that's done, we'll clean up any mess we made and get to work connecting the new fiber lines to homes and businesses. You'll be enjoying the fastest home internet in the Northwest in no time.

Note that the size and location of your neighborhood, as well as weather and other factors, can impact the timing of your project. We do everything we can to minimize disruptions and complete installation as quickly as possible.
