5.	LSR REMARKS				
	When Static IP service is ordered, the LSR Remarks must contain the name, phone number, and emain address of the technical contact. If not on the LSR, the PON Initiator will be contacted to provide technical information. Static IP blocks of 5 usable addresses must include the intended usage of the Static IP addresses.
